# Eligibility – International Masters Scholarships

## The University of Western Australia invites high achieving students to apply for a masters by coursework scholarship.

The masters by coursework international scholarship program is awarded to students who have demonstrated academic excellence in their undergraduate study and will undertake an applicable masters by coursework program in 2015 or 2016.

The value of each scholarship is determined by the applicant's undergraduate academic achievement and is awarded based on levels:

- AUD \$3000 per year for students with the equivalent to 70% in an Australian undergraduate degree; or
- AUD \$5000 per year for students with the equivalent of 75% in an Australian undergraduate degree; or
- AUD \$7000 per year for students with the equivalent of 80% in an Australian undergraduate degree.
